***Letchworth State Park- Catille Entrance***

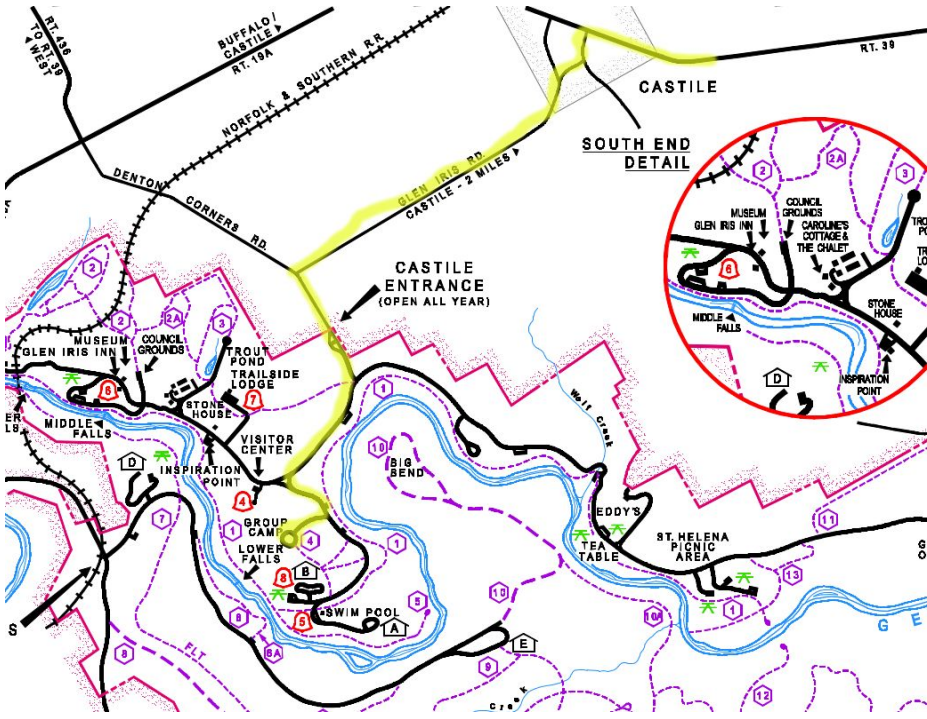
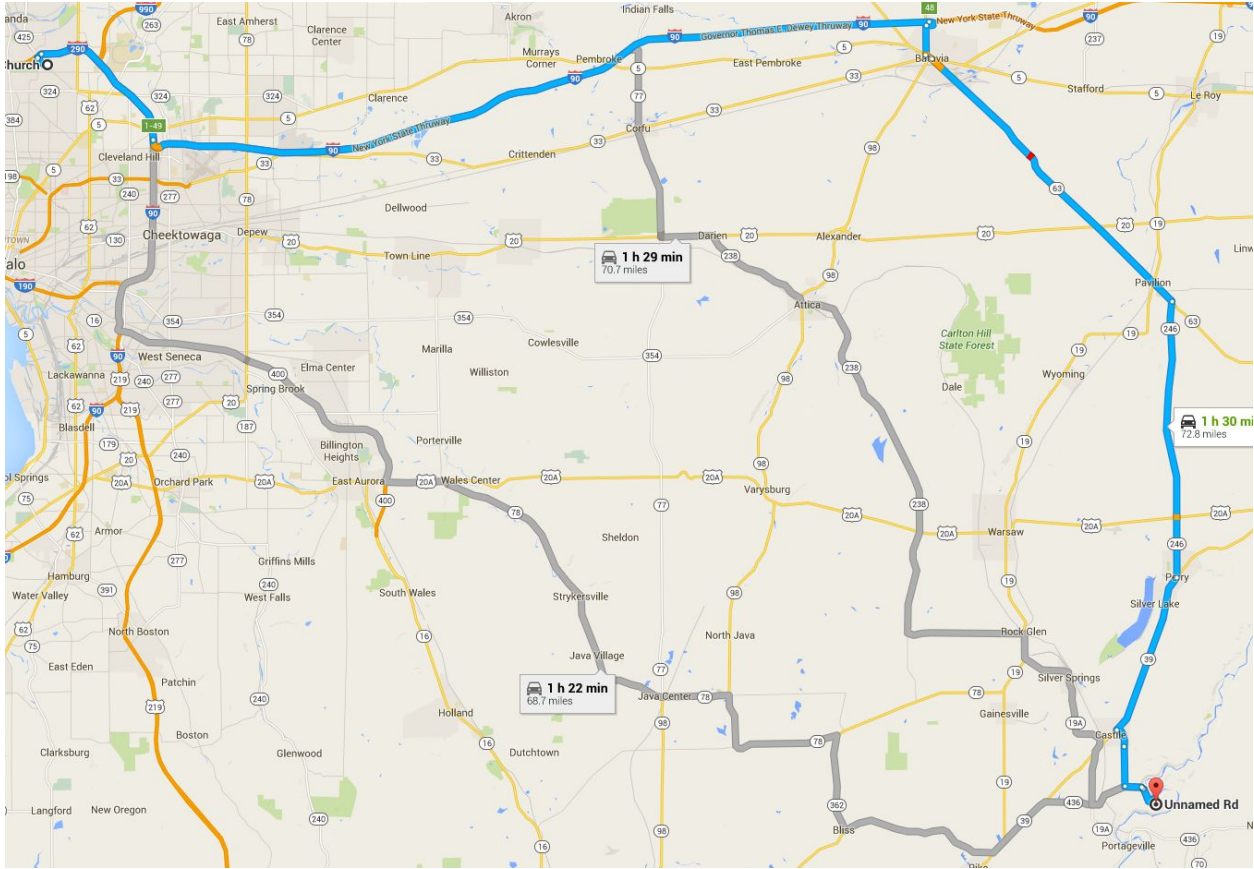
***County Road 38, Castile, NY 14427***

Arrive anytime after **7pm** on **Friday** - have dinner before arriving or bring your own; we'll break camp and leave after breakfast on Sunday.

- Bring a favorite board game for Friday night or down time.
- If you have a game or lawn activity (except Jarts) please feel free to bring it to have as an activity for any downtime that we might have.
- Friday (or Saturday) night we'll have a flag retirement ceremony - bring an old American flag if you have one. Please separate the field of blue & the 13 stripes, as they are placed into the fire one-by-one.
- Saturday's dinner is at 5:00; awards ceremony is at 6:30.
- This is a family camp-out – parents and siblings are invited. If you need a tent or have questions let us know; we can help you out.
- Cost is \$20 per adult, \$15 per sibling for the entire weekend, or \$10 for Saturday only
- Rain or shine – we will be camping!

### **Directions from St. Amelia RC Church (St. Amelia Drive, Tonawanda, NY)**

- Head Northwest on Eggert Road
- Take the Interstate 290 E ramp
- Take exit 1-49 on the left to merge onto 90 E toward Albany (Toll road) 30.4 miles
- Turn left onto NY 98 South
- Turn left onto West Main Street
- Turn right onto NY-63 S/ Ellicott St 12.9 miles
- Turn right on NY-246 south (10.5 miles)
- Slight right onto NY-39 W/ South Main Street (6.3 miles)
- Turn left onto E. Park Road (.8 mile)
- Turn left onto Denton Corners Road
- Entrance will be on this road.
- Turn right on Park Road,
- Entrance to group camping will be the first left

## COMFORT

- Tent
- Tarp (Groundcloth)
- Sleeping Bags & Camp Pillows
- Air Mattresses or Foam Pads
- Flashlights w/ Extra Batteries
- Folding / Camp Chairs

## COOKING / DINING

- Cup w/ lid & labeled (water bottle is fine)

## OPTIONAL ACCESSORIES

- Camera
- Books (Tree / Bird Identification or Other)
- Binoculars
- Compass
- Tent Broom
- Board Game for Game Night
- Notebook and Pen
- Cub Scout Handbooks
- Sports equipment, bat, ball, glove, football, flying disk toy, etc.
- Whistle, compass
- Fishing pole & supplies

## HYGIENE / SAFETY / CLOTHING

- Insect / **Mosquito Repellent**
- **Sunscreen** (SPF 30+)
- Sunglasses
- Toilet kit – toothpaste and brush, soap, small towel, deodorant, toilet paper, tissues, hand sanitizer
- Waterproof boots (grass is wet from dew in AM) & sneakers
- Clothes For weekend
  - Shorts (*NO CAMOUFLAGE*)
  - Pants / Jeans (NO CAMOUFLAGE)
  - Socks – 2 extra
  - T-Shirts (*NO CAMOUFLAGE*)
  - Long-sleeved shirt (*NO CAMOUFLAGE*)
  - Sleeping attire
  - Underwear - 2 extra
  - Rain gear
- Sweatshirt and/or Jacket
- Hat: a baseball cap for the day
- **Class "A" uniform** (button-down) - for ceremonies + New neckerchief for moving up
- Class "B" uniform (yellow t-shirt) - for other times
- Water bottle or canteen
- Plastic trash bag - 2
- Large zip lock – 2
- Rain gear (not that we'll need it)

## ***DO NOT BRING!!***

- Pets
- Fireworks
- Bicycles, Skateboards
- Guns, archery items, swords, knives or other weapons whether real or fake
- Alcohol
- Valuable items of any kind
- Camouflage clothing
